

## 2005

### FLORIDA

- Blacks comprise 14% of Florida's adult population, but 49% of the 101,013 AIDS cases and 53% of the 35,584 HIV cases reported through December 2005.
- In 2005, Blacks accounted for 45% of AIDS cases in men and 70% of those in women.
- In 2005, Blacks accounted for 42% of HIV cases in men and 66% of those in women.
- In Florida, 81,657 adults are currently living with HIV/AIDS, 41,727 (51%) of whom are black..
- In 2005, 1,,529 black men were reported with AIDS.
- In 2005, black women comprised 1,041 of the 1,486 reported AIDS cases among women and 1,099 of the 1,670 women who were reported with HIV.
- In 2005, the AIDS case rate among black women was 22 times higher than that among white women. The Hispanic to white rate ratio for females was 3.6:1
- In 2005, the AIDS case rate among black males was 7 times higher than that for white males.
- Of the 1,876 pediatric HIV/AIDS cases through 2005, 80% were among blacks. Black children less than 13 years old made up 21% of Florida's population (under age 13) in 2005.
- Black men who have sex with men accounted for almost 30% of reported AIDS cases in 2005 and heterosexual men accounted for 26%.
- Heterosexual contact was the mode of transmission in 2005 for 65% of black women.

### MIAMI-DADE

- Blacks comprise 20% of Miami-Dade County's population, but 51.6% of the 29,135 AIDS cases and 51% of the 10,486 HIV cases reported through December 2005.
- In 2005, Blacks accounted for 47.6% of AIDS cases in men and 75.1% of those in women.
- In 2005, Blacks accounted for 39.7% of HIV cases in men and 65.6% of those in women.
- In Miami-Dade County, 11,738 blacks adults are currently living with HIV/AIDS.
- In 2005, 403 black men were reported with AIDS as off 846 total male reported.
- In 2005, black women comprised 303 of the 403 reported AIDS cases among women and 280 of the 427 women who were reported with HIV.
- In 2005, the AIDS case rate among black women was 16 times higher than that among white women. The Hispanic to white rate ratio for females was 4.6:1
- In 2005, the AIDS case rate among black males was 3 times higher than that for white males.
- Of the 621 pediatric HIV/AIDS cases through 2005, 85% were among blacks. Black children less than 14 years old made up 26.4% of Miami-Dade population (under age 14) in 2005.
- Black men who have sex with men accounted for 15% of reported AIDS cases in 2005 and the same percentage among heterosexual men.
- Heterosexual contact was the mode of transmission in 2005 for 64.7% of black women.

KEY POINTS	
<b>LATE TESTING</b>	56% of people who were diagnosed with AIDS within 1 year of testing positive for HIV were blacks, according to the results of one study.
<b>SEXUAL IDENTITY</b>	In a study that examined HIV-infected people, 34% of black men reported bisexual behaviors. However, only 6% of black women reported having bisexual partner.
<b>DRUG USE</b>	Injection drug use is the 2nd and 3rd leading cause of HIV infection for black women and men, respectively. Drug users are more likely to have unprotected sex when under the influence.
