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## INTRODUCTORY NOTE TO NEW QUARTERLY REPORT VERSION

**Due to the new implementation of a computerized system of entering, retrieving and analyzing HIV/AIDS data in our state, electronic HIV/AIDS Reporting System [eHARS], there are some changes reflected in the way to process and present the information, different from the old HIV/AIDS Reporting System [HARS] This new way to produce data is reflected in the format in our report including more information than before. Henceforth the data referred to HIV and AIDS cases will exclude those from Department of Correction [DOC], instead DOC information is provided in a single table due to the small number of cases reported from DOC. New tables will reflect information for People Living with HIV or AIDS in Monroe County in a separate worksheet and useful website link added will provide a new tool to find HIV/AIDS related data beyond Monroe County as well. All these changes will allows Monroe County Health Department Administration and public in general to have more detailed information concerning HIV/AIDS. This report will be produced quarterly.**
