***Training for individuals who intend to be HIV counselors, it is also available for case managers. Test will be taken after first half of first day, which is a pre-requisite to enter the 501. Individuals must attend all three days.

Who is this training available for?

Everyone, but people who works for registered testing sites have priority over those coming from the private sector.

This practicum will be provided to each participant on the last day of the course. Once this practicum is completed and returned to the Early Intervention Consultant in the Office of HIV/AIDS, a Certificate of Attendance and Completion will be sent back to the participant via mail.
